**HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION FOR PRODUCT**

**EMERGENCY and FIRST AID PROCEDURES**

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult or discomfort persists, obtain medical attention.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water. Give large amounts of water to cause dilution in stomach.

Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

Skin: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

**EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE (Acute and Chronic)**

Inhalation: Irritant, chronic exposure may cause bronchitis.

Ingestion: May cause corrosion of mouth and gastrointestinal tract with vomiting, diarrhea or circulatory collapse.

Eyes: Irritant. Prolonged contact may lead to corneal or conjunctival ulceration.

Skin: May cause irritation to skin.

**PREVENTIVE MEASURES**

Steps to be taken upon release or spillage (including neutralizing):

Dike and salvage or neutralize with soda ash or lime. Small spills can be flushed with water.

Waste disposal method:

Neutralized acid can be flushed with water.

Handling and Storage Requirements:

Keep container closed when not in use. Freezes at temperature above 0°C. Use with adequate ventilation. Wash with soap and water after handling.

Ventilation Requirements (Local or General):

Use under well ventilated area.

Respiratory Protection:

A mask should be worn if use conditions generate vapours or mists.

Eye Protection:

Safety glasses with sideshields or chemical goggles.

Other Protection:

Rubber gloves and coveralls should be worn.
