EMERGENCY and FIRST AID PROCEDURES

PREVENTIVE MEASURES

Dispose of by controlled burning (approved incinerator) or land-fill absorbed material in government approved site.

Handling and Storage Requirements:

Keep container closed. Store in well ventilated areas. Keep away from incompatibles, sparks and open flames.

Ventilation Requirements (Local or General):

Use in well ventilated area.

Respiratory Protection:
